#### Theme:

This unit aims to offer a measure of continuity and progression in ICT through the important transitional phase between KS2 and KS3. It provides pupils with an opportunity to display their knowledge and understanding with regard to some aspects of the strands of ICT capability contained within National Curriculum requirements, and as fleshed out through the QCA Scheme of Work for ICT. This is a unit in which pupils will produce a Multimedia presentation based on key features and memories of their primary experiences. It will also incorporate an element of finding and selecting web-based information on the receiving school, to be included in the presentation. A copy of the pupil's presentation should be forwarded as stored media to the receiving secondary school in order to provide useful information and assessment material.

#### Where the unit fits in:

This is a stand-alone unit to be taught leading up to transition to Year 7. It assumes that the Key Stage 2 programme of study for ICT has been covered in full. It will provide pupils with the opportunity to revise and consolidate elements contained within the strands of ICT capability as outlined in the National Curriculum. It will also give pupils a chance to reflect not only on their primary experiences but also their progress in ICT. The unit will provide a context in which pupils can think ahead to new experiences both socially and with regard to extending their knowledge, skills and understanding in ICT.
